15 head of 2 1/2 year old purebred Brahman heifers; 4 pairs with F1 babies; 11 head bred 1st and mostly 2nd trimester to New Design/or In Focus Angus bulls. These heifers are very fancy and will weigh between 1100 and 1200#. (JB)

25 head of F1 Brahman X Hereford 2-2 1/2 year olds bred 1st and mostly 2nd trimester to New Design or In Focus Angus bulls. **15 head** will weigh 1150#-1200# and **10 head** will weigh 1075#.(JB)

15 head of F1 Brahman X Hereford 2-2 1/2 year olds bred 1st trimester to New Design or In Focus Angus bulls.(JB)

14 head of F1 Brahman X Hereford 2-2 1/2 year olds bred 2nd trimester to New Design or In Focus Angus bulls.(JB)

10 head of Brangus type females, bred 2nd trimester to Angus bulls. (JB)

40 head of Brangus heifers selling exposed and bred to LBW Angus bulls; a few of the heifers will begin calving in January. Females will be palpated and sorted to look alike and be bred alike. (BN)

9 head of F1 Brahman X Hereford 6-7 year olds bred to calve in the spring to Hereford or Angus or Brahman bulls.(UL)

10 head of 4 yr old Red Angus cows; mostly with calves at side, with two or three heavy bred to Red or Black Angus bulls. (5S)

8 head of 14 month old Purebred Charolais heifers; ready to breed; papers available at buyer's expense. FANCY (GW)

19 head of Charolais females; 13 pairs (calves by Angus bulls) cows are mostly 4 yr olds, with few 5's; 4 bred cows, bred to Angus bull and 2 hd of coming two year old heifers bred to Angus bull. (HF)

29 head of fancy Reg. Brangus 2nd and 3rd calf females; (papers furnished with breeding info, buyer to pay transfer) selling heavy bred to Reg. Brangus bulls. These females are good enough to go into a registered program. (BH)

20 head of fancy Brangus heifers sell heavy bred to LBW Angus bulls. These heifers will calve in February and March. (BH)

15 head Brahman cross (Braford type) 4 and 5 years cows; all with fall calves mostly by Angus bulls. (B&C)

15 head of crossbred 4 and 5 year old cows, selling 6+mo bred to Angus bulls.(B&C)

9 head purbred Angus cows, 7 head of 5 year olds either heavy bred or with calves, 2 head of 3-4 yr olds with calves. (JM)

4 head of purebred Angus heifers bred to calve in the spring to Angus bulls. (JL)

7 head of Registered Angus heifers bred to calve in the spring to Angus bulls. (JL)

6 head of open ready to breed crossbred heifers(JM)

7 head of mixed crossbred heifers bred to Angus bull to calve in the spring (MS)

20 head of mixed Gelbvieh Balancer X F1 BxH females.....some will be bred, some will be ready to breed. (KC)

3 head of Maine Anjou X Angus yearling, ready to breed females. (AD)

26 head of 6-7 yr old Brangus X cows, will calve in the spring to horned Hereford bulls. (BS)

18 head of Brangus X cows, 7-8 yr olds, 2 pairs and the rest to calve in the spring to Brangus bulls. (RB)

40 head of 3-6yrs Braford and Brangus cows; 20 pairs and 20 heavy bred to Angus and/or Charloais bulls. (JF)

10 head of Club calf females; Maine/Sim/Ang crosses; 1 pair; 4 heavy bred to Angus bull; 3 hfs exposed to Angus bull; 2 open (ES)

2 head weaned Brangus Gold heifers 11mo old (FS)

1 head Registered Charolais heifer; show quality female. (JK)

18 head of reputation Brangus Females (purebred-no papers); 6 head ready to breed weighing 800+ pounds; 12 hd ready to breed in the spring.(MC)
